Responsibilities

- Create & manage ingredient specifications

- Design protocol for testing of potential ingredients for recipe optimization and cost savings
- Communicate learnings on new ingredients with appropriate departments
 (R&D/QA/Regulatory/Procurement) and become knowledgeable on ingredient selection and replacement
- Perform shelf-life tests for new ingredients
- Coordinate line trials with Scheduling
- · Supervise trials and first production runs where new ingredients are used
- Aid Regulatory in performing risk analysis on new ingredients
- Request BOM changes in SAP template for changing recipes
