**The SAP Production Administrator** is responsible for managing the day-to-day SAP activities that support production operations. This role ensures production data is accurate, timely, and properly maintained in SAP to support scheduling, inventory control, reporting, and operational decision-making. The position works closely with Production, Planning, Inventory, and Quality teams to keep SAP aligned with what is actually happening on the floor.

### Responsibilities

- Enter, maintain, and validate production data in SAP, including production orders, confirmations, material consumption, and labor reporting
- Update and close production orders in SAP in alignment with daily production activity
- Troubleshoot and resolve SAP issues impacting production, escalating system issues as needed
- Coordinate with Production and Planning to ensure schedules and changes are accurately reflected in SAP
- Monitor data accuracy related to inventory movements, yields, scrap, and variances
- Analyze production and inventory data to identify trends, discrepancies, and improvement opportunities
- Support cycle counts and inventory reconciliation activities within SAP
- Generate standard SAP reports related to production, inventory, and performance metrics
- Create, maintain, and update documentation for SAP production processes, workflows, and system changes
- Develop, update, and deliver training to employees on SAP production functions and system usage
- Provide ongoing support to SAP users by monitoring recurring issues, following up on errors or data discrepancies, and retraining employees as needed to ensure proper SAP use
- Ensure compliance with internal controls, procedures, and data integrity standards
- Participate in continuous improvement efforts related to SAP processes and production workflows

- 2+ years of experience working in SAP or an equivalent ERP system within a manufacturing or production environment
- Strong analytical skills with the ability to interpret production and inventory data and identify issues

- High attention to detail and strong data accuracy skills
- Ability to work in a fast-paced production environment and manage multiple priorities
